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**ANIMAL CONTROL DIVISION MONTHLY REPORT FOR  
JANUARY 2014**

**Program Highlights**

- Volunteers donated approximately 238.5 hours in January in the areas of shelter office support, adoption assistance, kennel/cage cleaning, photography and, one spay/neuter clinic event. Of the 238.5 hours, 32 of those hours were attributed to the spay/neuter clinic in Tehachapi which resulted in 18 dogs and 17 cats for a total of 35 pets spayed/neutered. In addition, 49 microchips, 21 licenses, 42 Rabies, 17 DHPP and 19 FVRCP vaccinations were administered.
- January was a busy month once again for media contact, inquiries and interviews for the Department. The Marketing & Promotions Associate responded to 24 media inquiries and requests providing information to the media on various topics including field services, pet safety tips, operations, adoption promotions and the Countywide spay/neuter project. Of those 24 contacts, 10 resulted in interviews for newspaper, television and radio media outlets.
- The Rescue Team made four trips to transport a total of 171 animals to Northern California, Southern California and Eastern California this month. A total of 271 animals were saved by rescue organizations in January.
- Our Foster Program continues to grow and save more lives. 32 new animals entered the foster care program during the month of January.
- Starting July 1, 2013, the Department implemented its first ever Trap-Neuter-Return (TNR) program for feral and free-roaming cats, joining thousands of other agencies across the country embracing TNR as the humane method to control the feral and free-roaming cat populations. The program has been extremely successful with 88 cats being spayed or neutered and returned to the areas where they were trapped in January. The total number of cats that have been altered since the beginning of the program is 740.
- The Department successfully completed its 3<sup>rd</sup> Annual Home 4 the Holidays adoption promotion, which ran November 1, 2013 through January 4, 2014. All dog adoption fees were reduced to just \$15 and all cat adoption fees were reduced to just \$5. A total of 683 adoptions took place during this year's event, which was an increase of 33 adoptions over the same time period as last year.
- One successful low-cost vaccination, licensing and microchip clinic was held in Bakersfield (North Beardsley Park). 113 licenses, 134 Rabies vaccinations, 113 DHPP vaccinations and 13 FVRCP vaccinations were administered at this clinic. A total of 85 free microchips were implanted during this vaccination clinic.
- The inaugural "Your Team Needs an Extra Set of Paws" adoption promotion was a huge success. The week-long Super Bowl themed adoption event ended with 95 animals finding new forever homes. This was a huge increase over the same time period last year where only 39 pets were adopted in one week.
- We continue to provide free microchips for all pet owners both onsite at all three shelters and at our low-cost clinic locations. We have implanted a total of 4,402 microchips for County and City residents since the program began on October 23, 2012.

- The Department's medical team was extremely busy this month performing 49 spays and 45 neuters on site for a total of 94 surgeries performed.
