**ANIMAL SERVICES MONTHLY REPORT FOR  
NOVEMBER 2014**

**Program Highlights**

- Volunteers donated approximately 1027.25 hours in November in the areas of animal care, PEET canvassing, socialization, administration needs, grooming, cleaning, training, photography and several special events. There were 106 active volunteers in November. Of the 1027.25 original hours, 757.75 hours were completed by regular KCAS volunteers, 76.50 hours were completed by one-day volunteers, 8 hours were completed by an employment preparation volunteer, and 185 hours were completed by work release volunteers. Total volunteer time equates to 6.4 staff members and the value given back to KCAS by current and new volunteers in all areas is \$25,424.44.
- November was a busy month once again for media contact, inquiries and interviews for the Department. The Marketing & Promotions Associate responded to 38 media inquiries and requests providing information to the media on various topics such as field services including wildlife calls; Home 4 the Holidays adoption promotion; vaccination clinics; spay/neuter resources, responsible pet ownership vs. irresponsible pet ownership, Happy Kern Cats, Killer the dog, Animals for Armed Forces adoption event and operations. Of those 38 contacts, 20 resulted in interviews or postings for newspaper, television and radio media outlets via video, newsprint on the news agency websites and papers and on Facebook pages.
- November 1st kicked-off the Department's 4<sup>th</sup> Annual Home 4 the Holidays adoption promotion, which runs through January 10, 2015. All dog adoption fees have been reduced to just \$20 and all cat adoption fees have been reduced to just \$10. The event has been very successful in the first month with 327 animals finding their forever homes, which is an increase of 31 adoptions over the same time period last year. The Department looks forward to finding even more homes for pets in December.
- The Rescue Team made two trips to Northern California during the month of November, resulting in 71 animals finding new forever homes. In addition to the two transports to Northern California, rescue partners saved a grand total of 137 animals in November.
- Our Foster Program continues to grow and save more lives. 25 new animals entered the foster care program during the month of November.
- KCAS joined forces with the Animals for Armed Forces Foundation to offer a special adoption event for Veterans, Active Duty and military family members in honor of Veterans Day. All three shelters participated in free adoptions for Veterans, Active Duty and military family members on Saturday, November 8<sup>th</sup> and additionally, on Sunday, November 9<sup>th</sup>, the Bakersfield Shelter opened its doors for 4 hours for adoptions. The weekend was a huge success with 45 total adoptions. Of those 45 adoptions, 16 were military related adoptions (12 dogs and 4 cats.) The Animals For Armed Forces Foundation partners with shelters to offer the free adoptions and reimburses the shelter for the military adoptions. Plans are under way for the Department to participate in the next event set for Memorial Day weekend.

- Starting July 1, 2013, the Department implemented its first ever Trap-Neuter-Return (TNR) program for feral and free-roaming cats, joining thousands of other agencies across the country embracing TNR as the humane method to control the feral and free-roaming cat populations. The program has been extremely successful with 178 cats being spayed or neutered and returned to the areas where they were trapped in November. The total number of cats that have been altered since the beginning of the program is 2440.
- KCAS hosted two successful, low-cost vaccination, licensing and microchip clinics in Bakersfield (Fruitvale Norris Park) and Lost Hills (Lost Hills Park). 175 licenses, 176 Rabies vaccinations, 173 DHPP vaccinations, 7 FVRCP vaccinations, and 77 free microchips were implanted during these vaccination clinics.
- The Happy Kern Cats II Grant sponsored by KCAS and PetSmart Charities® held two informational meetings/trainings for interested feral/free-roaming colony care-takers in November. Each training provided an overview of the grant and the requirements along with information on how to spay/neuter their colony with the grant partner – Critters Without Litters.
- The Department's new Wednesday evening vaccination, licensing and microchipping clinics at the new Fruitvale Shelter location in Bakersfield continued in November with 109 DHPP vaccinations, 13 FVRCP vaccinations, 124 Rabies vaccinations, 112 licenses and 100 microchips issued during the three Wednesday evening clinics. The Department plans to continue to offer the Wednesday evening clinics on an on-going basis to assist pet owners in keeping their pets healthy and happy.
- November was a busy month for the Department, partnering with 4<sup>th</sup> District Supervisor David Couch, 1<sup>st</sup> District Supervisor Mick Gleason, the Kern County Library, Buttonwillow Recreation & Park District and the Kernville Odd Fellows to provide spay/neuter surgeries to residents in the Buttonwillow and Kern River Valley areas. 75 animals were spayed or neutered during these two events in Buttonwillow and Kernville. Special thanks to Dr. Willis and his mobile veterinary team from San Joaquin Veterinary Hospital for performing the surgeries. The Department will continue partnering with additional agencies and the Board of Supervisor members to bring spay/neuter services to as many unincorporated residents as possible.
- KCAS hosted three Sunday adoption events at the PetSmart store, located on Oswell in Bakersfield, in November. Staff showcased a number of adoptable dogs during the events and were successfully able to adopt out a total of 10 dogs. Staff's goal is to incorporate volunteers into the program to eventually take over the Sunday events.
- We continue to provide free microchips for all pet owners both onsite at all three shelters and at our low-cost clinic locations. We have implanted a total of 7,608 microchips for County and City residents since the program began on October 23, 2012.
- The Department's medical team was extremely busy this month performing 54 spays and 54 neuters on site for a total of 108 surgeries performed.

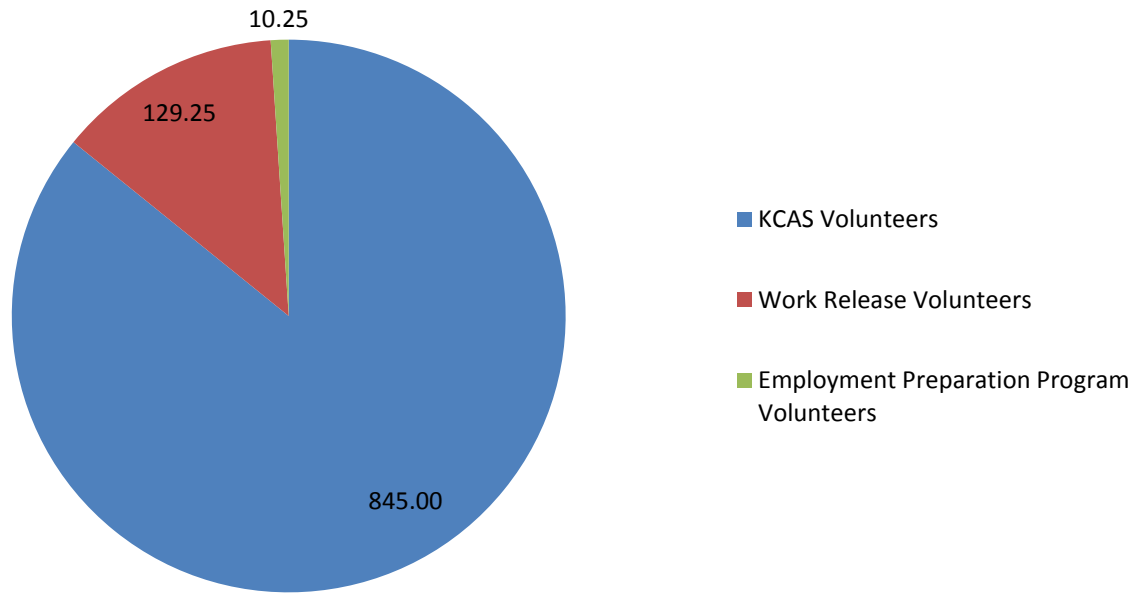
