Program Highlights

Rescue

- Rescue partners helped place 126 animals in December

Foster

- KCAS Foster program continues to grow and in the month of December 58 animals entered foster care

TNR

- In 2013 KCAS implemented a Trap-Neuter-Return (TNR) program. Through December 2015, 3,824 cats have gone through the TNR Program

Spay/Neuter clinics

- In December KCAS held one successful mobile spay/neuter and vaccination clinic combined in Buttonwillow.
- A total of 12 surgeries were performed at the Buttonwillow clinic

Adoptions

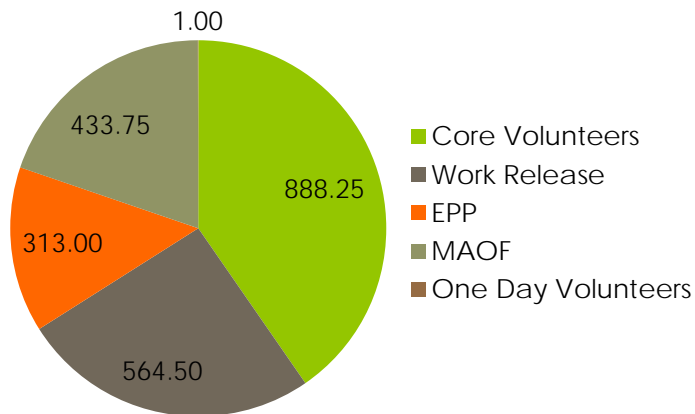


- KCAS held their 5th annual *Home for the Holidays* event which began November 2nd, 2015

- Year-to-date 4,133 animals have been adopted

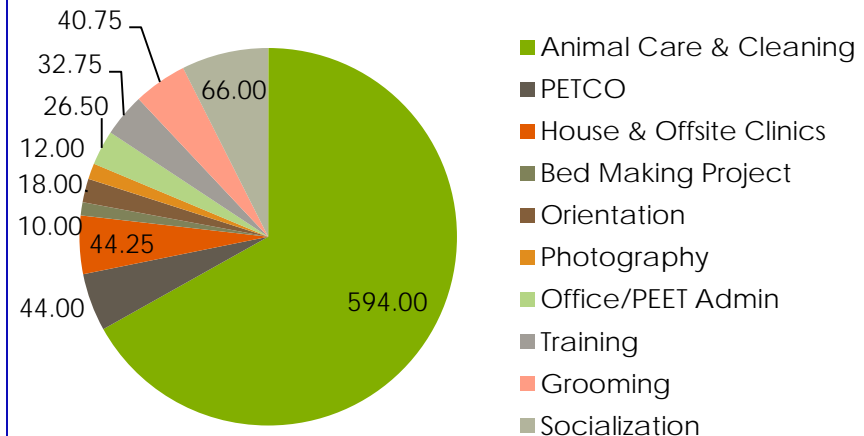
Volunteers
