# Program Highlights

## Rescue

- Rescue partners helped place 309 animals in January

## Foster

- KCAS Foster program continues to grow, and in the month of January 33 animals entered foster care

## TNR

- In 2013 KCAS implemented a Trap-Neuter-Return (TNR) program. Through January 2016, 3,909 cats have been altered through the TNR Program

## Adoptions

- In January 356 animals went to forever homes

## Spay/Neuter clinics

- In January we held two successful mobile spay/neuter clinics:
  - January 14<sup>th</sup>-15<sup>th</sup> in Taft
  - January 22<sup>nd</sup> in Frazier park
- Each day 30 surgeries were performed totaling 90 surgeries in January

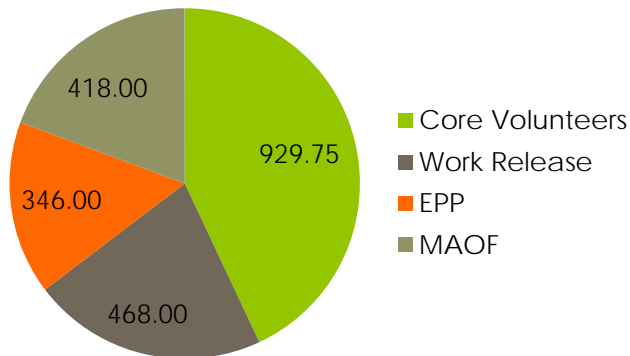

Between October 2012 and January 2016 KCAS has administered 10,844 microchips

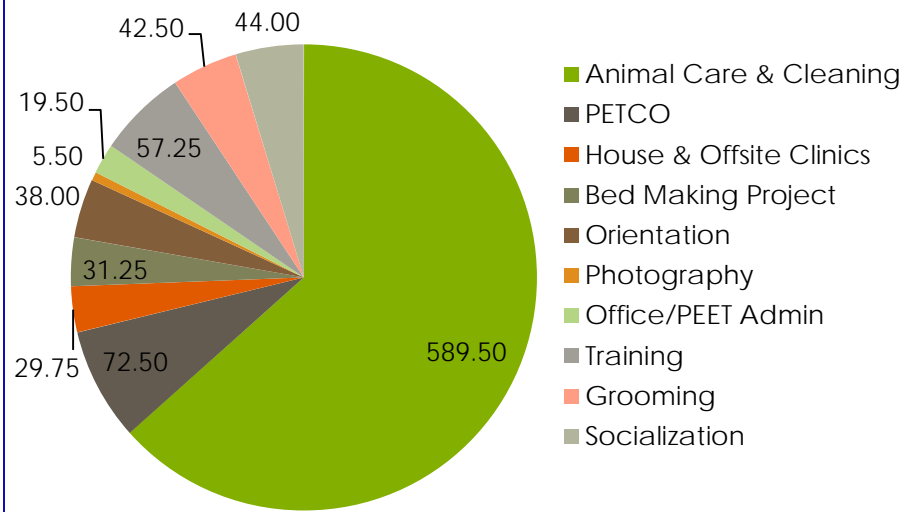
# Volunteers
