- In 2013 KCAS implemented a Trap-Neuter-Return (TNR) program. Through July 2017, 6,034 cats have been altered through the TNR Program.

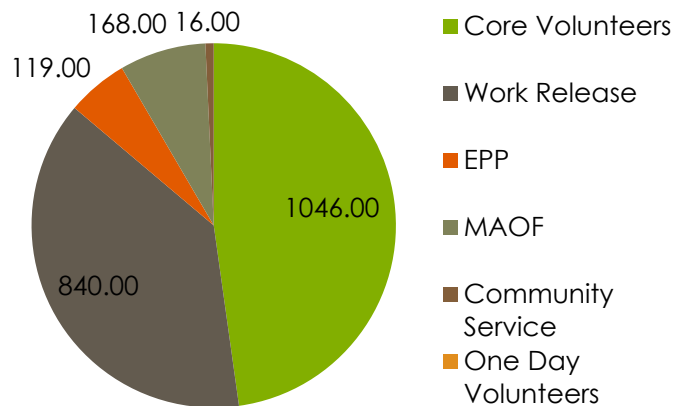

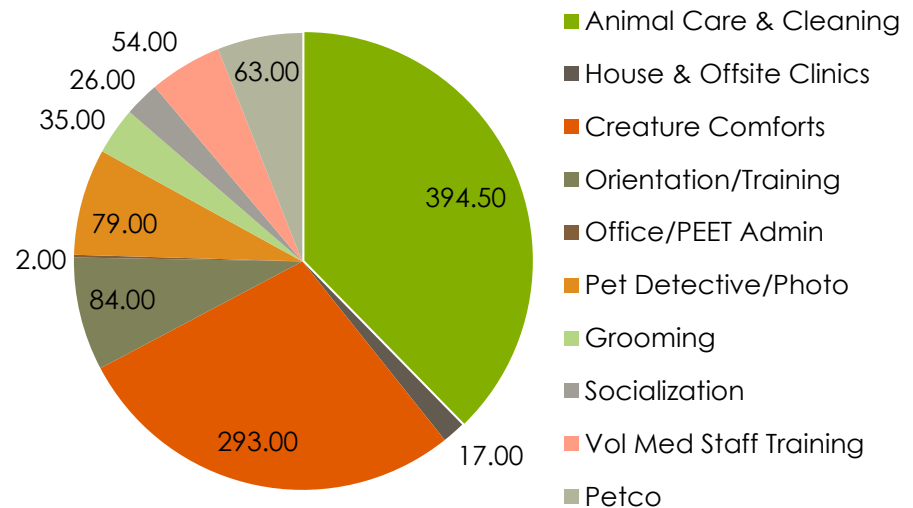
# Volunteers
