# Program Highlights

## Rescue

- Rescue partners helped place 165 animals in September

- In 2013 KCAS implemented a Trap-Neuter-Return (TNR) program. Through September 2017, 6,322 cats have been altered through the TNR Program.

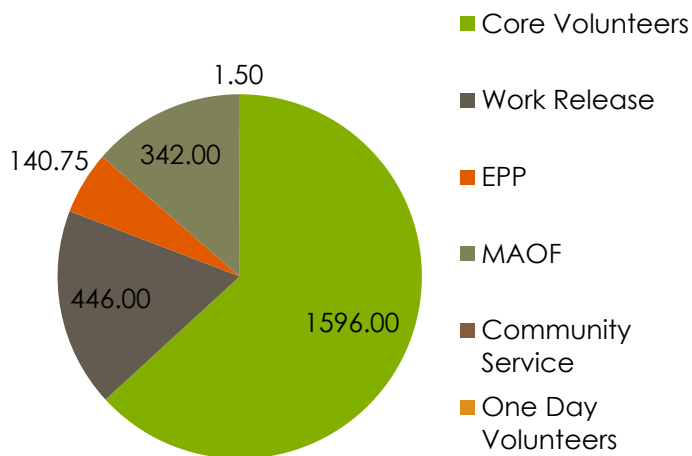

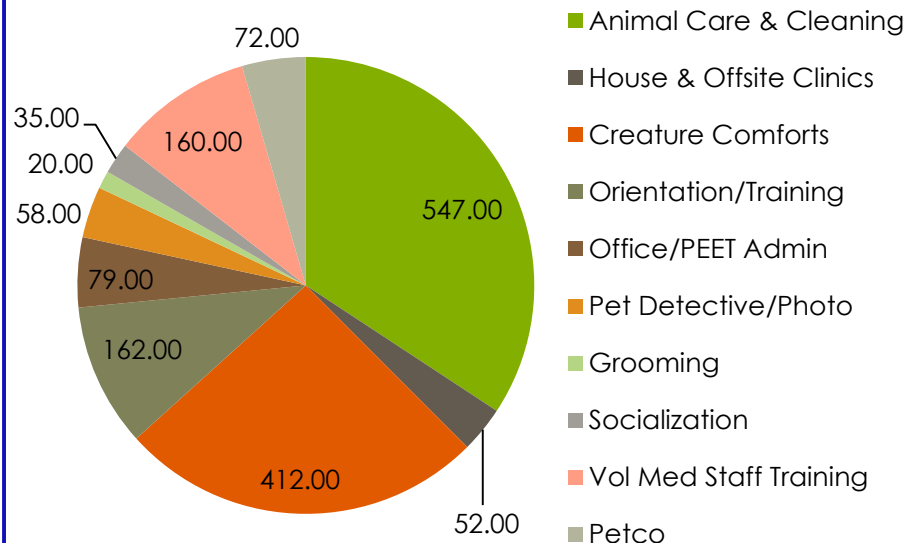
# Volunteers
