# Program Highlights

## Rescue

- Rescue partners helped place 202 animals in March

## TNR

- In 2013 KCAS implemented a Trap-Neuter-Return (TNR) program. Through March, 2018, 7,145 cats have been altered through the TNR Program.

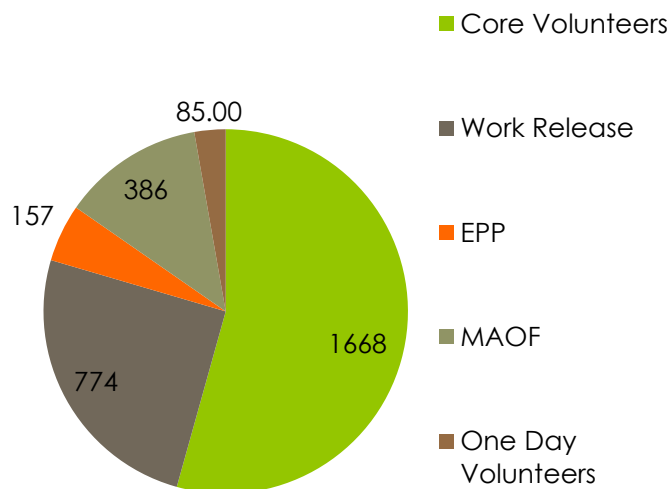

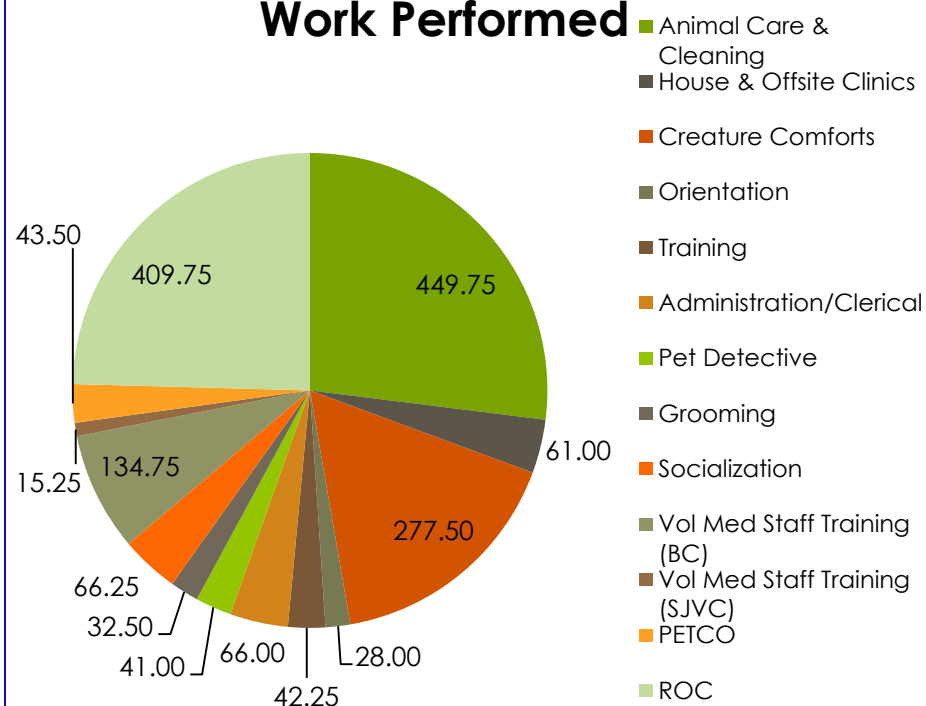
# Volunteers
