# Program Highlights

## Rescue

- Rescue partners helped place 421 animals in April

## Foster

- KCAS Foster program continues to grow, and in the month of April 155 animals entered foster care

## TNR

- In 2013 KCAS implemented a Trap-Neuter-Return (TNR) program. Through April, 2018, 7,332 cats have been altered through the TNR Program.

- 19 cats were adopted from Petco locations

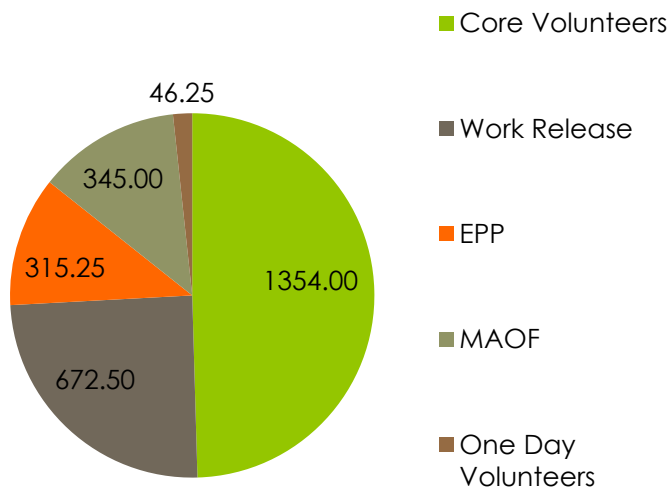
# The month of April held their 2<sup>nd</sup> Mega Adoption event



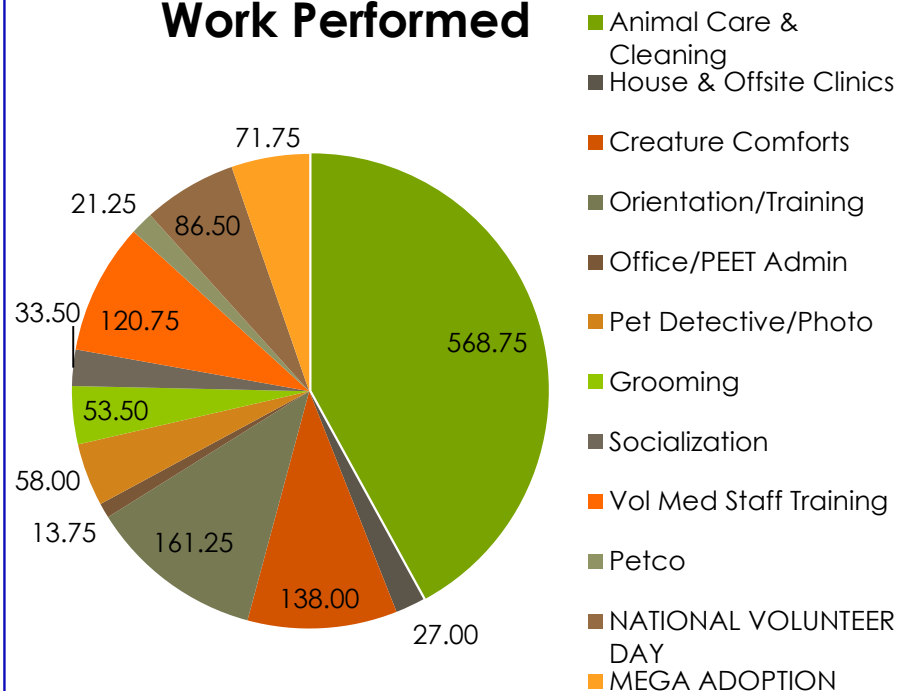
# Volunteers
