ANIMAL CONTROL DIVISION MONTHLY REPORT FOR January 2011

Program Highlights

- Volunteers donated approximately 280.5 hours in January in the areas of veterinary medical care, shelter office support, adoption center assistance, grooming, and off-site adoptions at Petco. One off-site event was held in January and accounted for 35.75 hours of the 280.5 total volunteer hours. Three dogs were adopted out as a result of these events.
- The Marketing & Promotions Associate conducted a tour of the animal adoption center for over 30 preschool age children from the Bakersfield Adult School Child Care Center. Students and their parents were given an up close and personal look at the animals for adoption and watched the adoption staff hard at work caring for animals and facilitating adoptions. Attendees received information on responsible pet ownership including how to avoid dog bites and what to do for pets to keep them happy and healthy.
- The Marketing & Promotions Associate was a guest on the recent *To Your Health* program. This segment featured information on the importance of keeping pets and humans healthy through exercise and how pet owners can provide exercise to their pets while having fun.

JANUARY PEET

The new Public Education and Enforcement Team personnel completed their ninth full month of canvassing in the unincorporated area of the county.

- 340 properties were surveyed.
- 364 Courtesy Notices were issued for dogs not having a current rabies vaccination or current dog license.
- 106 new dog licenses have been attributed to the PEET Program since January 1, 2011.
- 13% of all dog licenses issued since January 2011 have been attributed to PEET.
