**ANIMAL CONTROL DIVISION MONTHLY REPORT FOR**  
**November 2011**

**Program Highlights**

- Volunteers donated approximately 347 hours in November in the areas of veterinary medical care, shelter office support, adoption center assistance, grooming, cleaning assistance and off-site adoption events. One off-site adoption event was held at PETCO for a total of 29 hours of the original 347 volunteer hours. One dog was adopted out as a result of this event.
- The Marketing & Promotions Associate was a guest on the *To Your Health* program and on KERN Radio Newstalk 1180. Topics covered included the need for volunteers at the shelter, responsible pet ownership, cold weather safety tips, exercising to keep you and your pet healthy and, the importance of adopting from a shelter.
- The division conducted its first two surgery clinics as part of the Happy Kern Cats PetSmart Charities ® grant. The first clinic day resulted in 98 cats spayed and neutered. The second clinic day resulted in 51 cats spayed and neutered, for a total of 149 cats altered. Staff, community partners and volunteers continue to move forward with more surgery dates scheduled for December and January. The response from the public has been overwhelmingly supportive and positive as more and more community members continue to reach out and become part of the grant process.
- A special out-of-state rescue was coordinated between the Division and Las Vegas Adopt-a-Pet Rescue. A total of 35 dogs were loaded and transported from the Bakersfield shelter to Las Vegas where they found new homes. Staff and rescues continue to plan future transports to Northern and Southern California as well as out-of-state.
- Two successful low-cost vaccination and licensing clinics were held in Bakersfield and Oildale. 332 licenses, 440 Rabies vaccinations and 289 DHPP vaccinations were administered at these clinics.
