**ANIMAL CONTROL DIVISION MONTHLY REPORT FOR
July 2012**

Program Highlights

- Volunteers donated approximately 580.5 hours in July in the areas of shelter office support, adoption center assistance, medical assistance, cleaning assistance and off-site adoption events. One off-site adoption event was held at PETCO for a total of 48 of the original 580.5 volunteer hours. Unfortunately, no dogs were adopted at this event, however, educational information on spaying/neutering, responsible pet ownership and the joys of adopting a pet were provided to the public.
- The Happy Kern Cats PetSmart Charities® Grant to fund free spaying/neutering of feral and free-roaming cats in the targeted 93306 area continued with two more successful clinics in July. Due to the continued dedication and devotion of our volunteer and community partners, 1185 cats have been altered since the program began in November of 2011. Two more dates are scheduled for August.
- Staff made four trips to transport dogs and cats to rescue agencies in Santa Cruz, Castaic, Simi Valley and to the California/Nevada state line. Approximately 146 animals received new homes due to the transports by staff this month.
- Staff participated in two sessions of the Bakersfield SPCA's summer day camp for kids. Information regarding responsible pet ownership, animal control services and careers involving animals was provided to approximately 30 students.
- The Marketing & Promotions Associate was a guest on KGET 17's morning show and provided education and information on 4th of July safety tips for pet owners.
- Two successful low-cost vaccination and licensing clinics were held in Taft and Bakersfield. 299 licenses, 324 Rabies vaccinations and 237 DHPP vaccinations were administered at these clinics.
