An appointment is necessary for all surgical services. Vouchers are accepted from recognized Kern County animal agencies and non-profit organizations. Surgery costs are as follows: Female Cats \$50 & Male Cats \$40. Additional fees may be charged and current vaccinations are required.

## BAKERSFIELD - Kern County Animal Services:

KCAS has a voucher program for low income residents of Kern County. Vouchers are \$20 each and cover the entire cost of spay or neuter for any dog or cat. Vouchers can only be used at specified local vets. Limit 4 vouchers per person per lifetime.

KCAS also has a FREE TNR program for feral/free-roaming cats open to unincorporated County residents only (Bakersfield shelter only).

## BAKERSFIELD - Kern Humane Society:

KHS provides vouchers for low-income residents—\$15 for female cats and \$10 for male cats. These vouchers can be used at any local vet. Vouchers are only issued on the first Saturday of every month from 10 am to 3 pm. Limit of two vouchers per household.

The Foundation has a limited number of vouchers available each month. Vouchers are for \$20 off the cost of surgery for your cat. There is a limit of two (2) vouchers per household per calendar year. To request a voucher, please email [fkcasf@gmail.com](mailto:fkcasf@gmail.com) with name, mailing address and number of vouchers requested. Please specify the voucher is for a cat. Along with your voucher, you will receive a list of vets and clinics that accept the vouchers. If the month's allotment has been reached, you will be placed on a waiting list in the order that emails are received. Please note that vouchers are only available to Kern County residents and are not transferable. Vouchers cannot be used with KCAS vouchers.

## BAKERSFIELD - Serenity Cat Hospital

Performing low-cost surgeries since 2010, Serenity offers spays for \$85 and neuters for \$65. Appointments are preferred but not required and feral cats are welcome. Cats can be spayed/neutered with Serenity as

early as 8 weeks. Other low-cost services are available. Vouchers are accepted at time of presentation. Cats must be presented in a hard sided cat carrier with a clean towel for recovery and ferals should be in a trap.

Cats are transported to spay/neuter clinics every two weeks for residents in 93222, 93225 & 93243 zip codes. Kern Humane & Friends vouchers are accepted to offset the \$47.50 cost. Vaccinations and testing are available for an additional \$10.

Vouchers can be combined with Friends vouchers and used at most vets in Kern County. Vouchers are also available in \$30 to \$50 amounts to fund TNR of feral cats.
